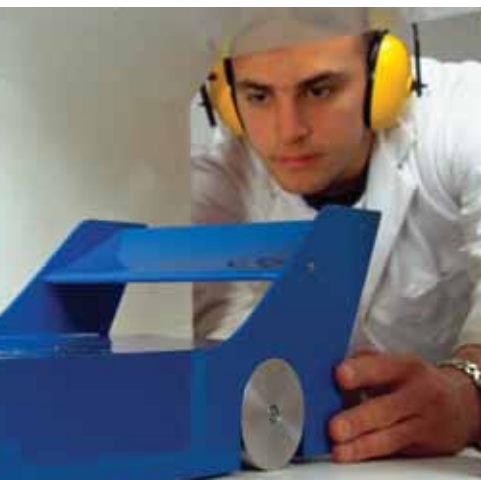

The NEBOSH National General Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety is a globally recognised health and safety qualification that is held by more than 100,000 people in the UK and world-wide.

What kind of people take the NEBOSH National General Certificate?

Managers, supervisors and staff from all types of organisations who need a broad understanding of health and safety issues. The certificate helps them manage risks effectively. Many people take the NEBOSH Certificate as a first step on a career in health and safety. It provides a valuable overview, and is a sound basis for further professional study.

What are the benefits for the organisation?

Many larger organisations choose the NEBOSH Certificate as a key part of their supervisors' or management development programme. By ensuring that line managers have a sound understanding of the principles of risk management they build an effective safety culture in the company.

Smaller organisations, operating in lower risk environments, often choose the NEBOSH certificate as the appropriate qualification for the manager taking the lead on health and safety issues.

The choice of course format can allow employers to fit training around the needs of the business. Many of NEBOSH's training providers will offer courses in-company, which allows for material reflecting the organisation's own systems of work or hazards to be included.

Is the NEBOSH Certificate a recognised qualification?

The NEBOSH Certificate is accepted by IOSH – the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health – in meeting the academic requirements for Technician Membership of IOSH (Tech IOSH). It is also accepted by The International Institute of Risk and Safety Management (IIRSM) for associate membership.

What does the course cover?

It covers the main legal requirements for safety in the UK, a range of workplace hazards, and methods of control.

The Certificate syllabus is based on the Employment National Training Organisation (ENTO) standards. These are reviewed regularly to keep up with developments in the workplace and in legislation.

Where can I take a course leading to the NEBOSH Certificate?

Details of over 400 training providers operating across the UK and overseas are on our website.

These training providers offer courses to fit around your requirements:

- Distance or blended learning
- Day or evening courses over a number of weeks
- Block release or modular courses

How is the course assessed?

Candidates are assessed with written examinations for each of the two taught units. A unit certificate is issued denoting successful achievement of each unit. A Certificate award parchment is issued on completion of the two units and the practical assessment.

How much does it cost?

Course fees are determined by your training provider and vary depending on the format of the course. Please contact providers for details.

The NEBOSH Certificate is at level 3 in the National Qualification Framework, and is accredited by QCA, CEA and DELLS
